

Procedure

Results

The first set of questions was to determine whether students were 1) Drop Outs, those students who rolonger plantocordine their education at Southeastern, including those who planton or have transferred describes 2) Stop outs, those students who planto return to Southeastern at some point. Based on these definitions, 692% (n=137) of the respondents were Drop Outs and 31.0% (n=61) were Stop outs


Stop Outs






Comparison to Previous Years
